Available for Assistant Professor Level faculty in Toxicology and Pharmacology with one to five years teaching experience. The Toxicology Forum is an international, non-profit organization that is devoted to conducting open dialogues among various segments of society concerned with problems in toxicology. Senior leaders from domestic and international government regulatory and health agencies, industry, academia, political policymakers and public interest groups will be attending. The Fellow will be able to interact in an informal setting with these scientists and be able to discuss important current toxicologic issues and the impact of these issues on risk assessment.

Those awarded Fellowships will be provided with up to \$1,500 to cover airfare, housing, ground transportation and incidentals. The meeting Registration Fee will also be waived. In addition, most meals are provided on site.

Selection of Fellows will be based on curriculum vitae and career focus in the areas relevant to the Toxicology Forum (See [www.toxforum.org](http://www.toxforum.org)). C.V.'s should be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from the Department Chair.
